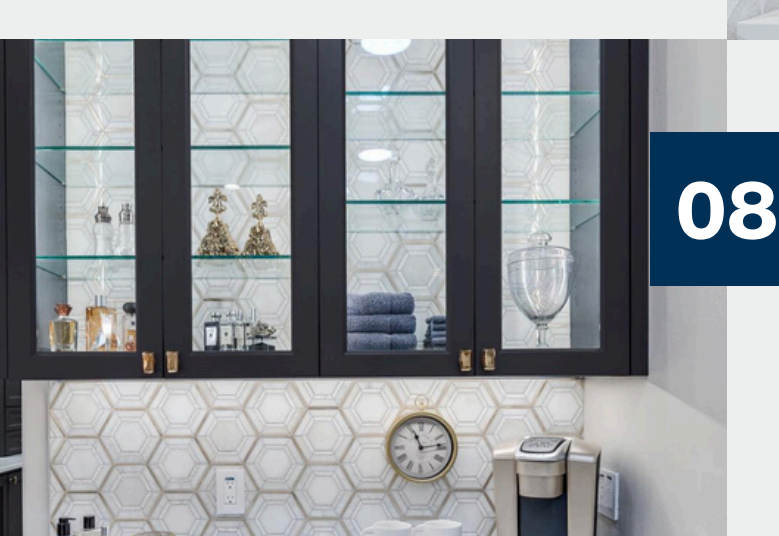
PERSONALIZED ACCESSORIES

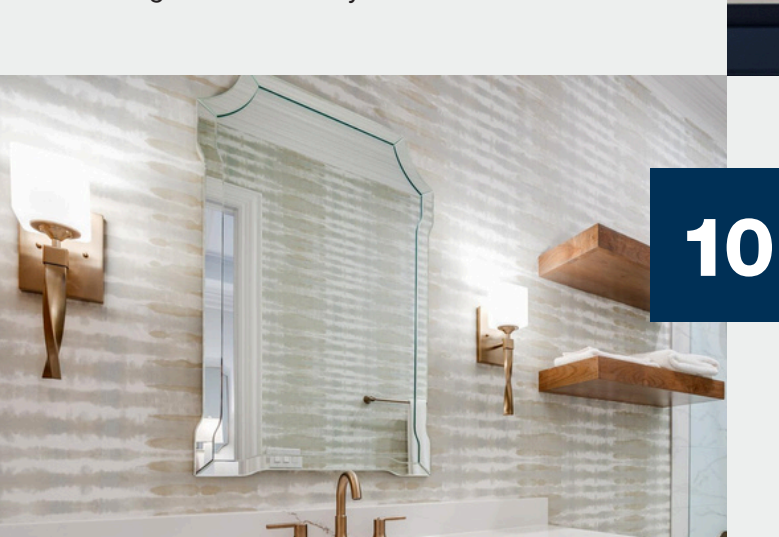
